Henry Jackson, III was born on March 3, 1966 in Lexington, Kentucky, the oldest son of Henry Jackson, Jr. and the late Virginia G. Jackson.

At an early age, Henry accepted Christ as his personal Lord and Savior. He was baptized at and became a member of Consolidated Baptist Church.

Henry was educated in the Fayette County Public School System and graduated from Bryan Station Senior High School in 1984. He furthered his schooling at the University of Kentucky, where he studied Finance.

Henry retired from Toyota Motor Manufacturing Kentucky as a Team Leader. He was one of the first employees hired at the Georgetown plant when it began producing the Toyota Camry in 1988, and was a dedicated employee there for over 30 years.

Henry was humbled to become a 32nd^o Degree Mason. He held the position of Marshall at St. Paul Lodge No. 11, Georgetown, Kentucky, a member of Mt. Carmel No. 3, Holy Royal Arch Masons of Lexington, and a Shriner of Ismid Temple No. 110 in Lexington.
