Rev. Howard Jackson, Sr. was born January 15, 1936 to the late James Jackson and Sadie Howard in Woodford County, Kentucky.

Rev. Howard Jackson was a retired employee of the Lexington Fayette Urban County Government. He also served as a security guard at Keeneland. During the Korean Conflict, he served as a Private in the US Marine Corps.

Early in his life, he became a member of Polk Memorial Baptist Church, Mortonsville, Ky, the family's place of worship. He later joined Corinthian Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. James Blair, where he announced his call to preach the Gospel. It was there he was licensed and ordained and was a faithful associate.
