the daily jobs until she had a heart attack and could not continue. She was able to

continue her work at Eastern State Hospital until her retirement after working 36

yrs.

Sis Jeralene was united in Holy matrimony to Robert Jay Johnson Sr. who preceded her in death in June, 1993. God blessed their union to which 13 children

were born. She had one brother, Raymond Knox Curtis, who preceded her in death.
