



## Mr. Larry Charles Arnold, Sr.

Larry Charles Arnold, Sr. was born October 8, 1952. He was the son of the late Cecil Arnold and Carolyn Adams. After a valiant fight with an extended illness, he received his eternal healing and departed this life on Monday, October 23, 2023.

Larry was raised in Lancaster, Kentucky where he attended Garrard County High School. He volunteered for the United States Army at the age of 17 and completed his high school education while in the military. He fought in the Vietnam War and received a National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, and Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal.

At an early age, he accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior at Bethel Temple Church in Lancaster. A lifetime member, Larry sang in the choir, taking the lead on favorites, "Oh, Happy Day" and "I'm Just A Nobody." He loved music and taught himself to play the electric guitar, piano, and organ. He loved to play the guitar and sing for his family.

Larry enjoyed riding his Harley Davidson and was a member of a motorcycle club. He also enjoyed spending time with his family, performing maintenance on his power tools, building model cars and motorcycles, and tending to his Bonsai trees.

An ambassador for the commonwealth, Larry was commissioned a Kentucky Colonel in December of 1991 by Governor Brereton C. Jones.

In addition to his parents, Larry was preceded in death by his grandmother, Flossie Beasley; his brother, Cecil Arnold; and sisters, Wanda Elizabeth

Adams and Frances Marsue Morton.
