Louise Berryman-Johnson was born on August 30, 1921, in Blackbridge, Kentucky, to the late Orine Berryman, Sr. and Katherine Taylor-Berryman. After an extended illness, God sent for her to depart this earthly life on February 10, 2021, and to be in presence of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Granny, Aunt Lou, Mrs. Louise or Great-Granny, as she was affectionately called by her family and friends, was the youngest of five children and grew up on the family property located in rural Jessamine County. There she learned the value of hard work, patience and love for her family.

Louise accepted Jesus Christ at an early age and united with the Macedonia Baptist Church of Blackbridge, Kentucky. There she remained a faithful member along with her family until relocating to Lexington. Later, when her illness prevented her from regular attendance, she would always reminisce about the days when she went to church and learned about God, whom she loved so much. Even when illness caused her to slow down, she always remember that, "There's not a friend like Jesus," and she sang it with vigor.

Louise met and married the late Oscar Johnson, Sr. in 1944, and unto this union four children were born, Oscar, Jr., William Orene, Martha Louise and Francis "Frank." She always spoke of her children and how much of a
