Elect Lady Magdelene Boyd was born on July 6, 1928 to the late Thomas Taylor Sr. and Margaret Gay Taylor in Lexington, Kentucky. She was married to the late Bishop V.I. Boyd.

She joined the House of God at a very early age. Her first pastor was the late Bishop S.L. Henry, followed by the late Chief Apostle, Bishop S.P. Rawlings. She served under the present Chief Apostle and General Overseer, Apostle T.E. Clark, Jr. until her death. She was the first Nurse's Guild president in the local church and saw to it that all the nurses received first aid training. She was the oldest member of the choir, former president of the Bishop Willing Worker Club and a vital member of the church's culinary staff until her 90's. Elect Lady Boyd loved to cook and feed the masses. She initiated the program to provide meals to the Saints who arrived on the Sabbath before convocation. She also provided meals to the many friends her grandchildren brought over to eat. In fact, at her home everyone was welcome at her table. In addition to her husband, Elect Lady Boyd was preceded in death by her siblings, Thomas Taylor, Jr., Bishop R.N. Taylor, Deacon Ethel Bert (Helen) Taylor, Rev. Walter (Lillian) Taylor, Alfred Taylor, Elect Lady Anna (Elder Henry) Ross, Lady Virginia (Ora) Johnson, Lady Margaret (Deacon Walter, Sr.) Robinson and a loving nephew, Frank Edward Taylor.
