Percy Hunter Brown was born August 12, 1932 and went home to be with the Lord Wednesday, February 4, 2015. A native of Fayette County, he was a son of the late Mr. William Brown, Sr. and Mrs. Bertha Lee Hayden Brown. He joined Bethsaida Baptist Church at 13 years of age and actively served until 1975, when he united with his family at Pleasant Green Missionary Baptist Church. Over thirty nine years Percy ministered in various positions as Deacon, Trustee, Sunday School Teacher, Vice-President of the Forty-Year Christians Group, Married Couples Club Counselor, President of the Senior Choir, and Layman.

Percy was a gentleman and a good steward of his time and resources. He respected the office of Deacon, enjoyed being a team-teacher for the Co-ed Sunday school class, and prayerfully prepared each week for service. He loved old hymns and could be heard singing above the roar of the Lawn Boy as he mowed the grass.
