Rhonda Elizabeth Winn, affectionately known as “Nonna,” was born into this world October 20, 1950. Eldest daughter of Warren G. Winn Sr. and Dorothy Berry Winn.

Rhonda was baptized at an early age under the pastorate of Rev. A.B. Lee.

Throughout her

childhood she was a member of the children and youth choir, The Young Missionary Society,

and The Red Circle Girls. As an adult she continued to share her gifts singing in the choir, as well

as teaching Children’s Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and Bible Study.

During her high school years at Dunbar, she was active in The Upward Bound Program at

Kentucky State University, which led her to become a student after graduating from Henry Clay

High School Class of 1968.

After returning home from college, she became an avid seamstress producing outfits daily just

to wear to her job at Irvine Ind. Not only did she spend her life sewing, reupholstering, and

decorating, she was also the community and family daycare. Taking after her father, she also had a fondness for electronics and fixing things, giving her the nickname "MacGyver!" and also leading her to pursue her Electronics Engineering Degree, starting school at age 50 in 2000. Upon graduating she received a promotion at Avnet Electronics where she worked as a computer chip programmer. Her employment lasted until the close of the company, leading her back to her first love, Home Daycare until she was unable to continue due to her failing health.

Rhonda was preceded in death by her father, Warren G. Winn Sr.; mother, Dorothy Berry Winn; sisters, Margie Buckner and Reba Stockton; brother, Stephen Sheldon Winn Sr.; and nephew, Brannon Scott Winn.

Rhonda was called home to be with her Heavenly Father on February 11, 2026 at the age of 75 after a triumphant battle with cancer.
