Veronica Arnez “Ronnie” Taylor was born on July 31, 1961, in Georgetown, Kentucky, to the late Phillip Marvin Taylor and Barbara Ann (Hale) Taylor. She was also preceded in death by her beloved son, Jared Taylor. Veronica unexpectedly departed this life on Sunday, August 24, 2025, after a brief illness.
