Bro. William T. Quisenberry, Jr., was born August 19, 1950, to the union of William and Gloria Quisenberry in Winchester, Kentucky. He was called from this life on Wednesday, February 22, 2017.

He was a graduate of Bryan Station High School. He later worked and retired after 27 years as an employee of the Dept. of Veterans Affairs Medical Center in 2005.

He united with the Main Street Baptist Church October 19, 1958, under the services of the late Pastor R. H. Johnson. Here he grew up as a youth attending Sunday School and the “Royal Ambassadors” (youth boys group). He later worked as a Youth Counselor (assisting the Youth Director—the late Sis. Virigina Thomas).
